PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE: FROM THE HOTEL CALIFORNIA TO THE INN BETWEEN

Mental health should be on the minds of all lawyers. We mostly work in critical situations where the outcome for clients is potentially win or lose, with the threat of ever looming sanctions, and counsel where civility is lost upon them. Further, we have cases involving pro se litigants who face mental health challenges, which has left the Courts to decide cases where perhaps former state hospitals would have housed the mentally ill.

State Hospitals in California were made known to me through the Eagles song and the album cover of a bell tower, which was not lost on me when I attended California State University, Channel Island ("CSUCI"), a former state mental hospital facility. Although it was later debunked as not being the bell tower on the album cover, the grounds at CSUCI were tranquil, having large trees and grassy quad areas. 1 would make time to enjoy the scenery for my mental health. Today, I take some solace in preparing for a crisis by having a Psychiatric Advance Directive (PAD), which allows individuals to prepare for a mental health crisis as they would for a physical crisis under an advanced health care directive.

In the late 1980s, most of the state mental hospitals were closed, which had served criminal and non-criminal individuals with mental illness or physical defects. Today, only four mental hospitals remain in California - Patton, Norwalk (Metropolitan), Atascadero, and Napa for criminal offenders. The offenders with mental health disorders are either restored for competency in order to go to trial; found not guilty by reason of insanity; or are being held for some or all of their parole due to being a danger to the public. A mentally ill prisoner who is incarcerated for a life sentence may become eligible for parole. A "lifer hearing" is held before a parole board and legal counsel is provided by the state to determine if the person should be paroled.

For those not housed, there are some programs and non-profit organizations attempting to solve the issue. We, in our Ventura County, now have the benefit of Care Court, which provides a mechanism to deliver mental health and substance abuse treatment and services. The importance is that by utilizing the Care Court program, participants and families will not have to wait for incarceration to obtain needed services.


As for the future, there is hope in programs such as the "Inn Between" program to evolve and prove to be a workable model of providing mental health and homelessness services to vulnerable people. As the name implies, the facility is like a motel that allows participants to receive services but also allows for independence of the participants. Currently, it is limited to hospice care as a component of the service.

I firmly believe that we should take time as lawyers to enjoy that activity that recharges our batteries so to speak and to avoid the "other" bar as a coping mechanism. Although we face many mental challenges and fatigue from the mental work we perform, we should treat each other with civility through honesty, integrity and courtesy, that will lead to longevity in the profession.

Perhaps Don Henley said it best — "Take it easy."

REFLECTIONS ON THE RECENT FIRES

I started my legal career in Ventura County commuting from Altadena to Santa Paula. Before then, I lived on the border of Santa Monica and the Pacific Palisades and I have held a Palisades Post Office box for six years, and before then I lived in Malibu for three years while attending law school.

The recent fires have touched and devastated the communities that I have had the special opportunity to experience and enjoy. Due to the Palisades and Eaton fires, communities have lost staple landmarks, businesses, religious centers, schools, homes that gave each community a unique character and identity. The structures were visible proof of each city's decades long history and held memories of generations of families and people, like me. The loss suffered by the Malibu, Pacific Palisades, and

JUDGE WALSH RETIRES

Judge Henry J. Walsh retired on January 5, 2024, from the Ventura Superior Court after almost 27 years of dedicated service.



Judge Walsh was appointed to the bench in 1998 by former Governor Pete Wilson. He filled the vacancy created by the death of the **Hon.** Frederick A. Jones.

Walsh's judicial assignments have included civil trials and family law. Walsh also served as the Presiding Judge of the Appellate Division, Supervising Civil Judge of the Ventura Superior Court, Chair of the Superior Court Jury/Grand Jury Committee, and Co Chair of the Expedited Jury Trial Pilot Program.

Prior to his appointment to the bench, Walsh was a civil litigation partner at the law firm of Lawler, Bonham, and Walsh beginning in 1985. He also worked as an attorney at Lawler and Ellis from 1980 to 1985 and for Kosmo, Walsh, and Cho from 1971 to 1980.

Walsh served as an officer in the United States Air Force and has been a member and director for the Organizational Charter 228 of the Inns of Court since 1994.

During his judicial career, Walsh received notable awards and honors including: the Ventura County Trial Lawyers Attorneys' Judge of the Year Award (2002) and the Knights of Columbus Council #750 Public Safety Award (2012) in recognition of his contributions to the community.

Walsh received his BA in 1965, Commission 2nd Lt. USAF from Stanford University in 1965 and earned his Juris Doctorate from Loyola Law School in 1970.

Judge Walsh and his wife Deanna live in Ventura and have successfully raised five children.

INTERFACE CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES AWARDED GRANT

The Ventura County Public Defender's Office, Interface Children and Family Services and Turning Point Foundation were recently awarded a \$7.3 million grant to connect people with non-violent criminal offenses with housing, treatment and ancillary services in the Ventura County Superior Court's criminal division.

Although the program is based in the misdemeanor arraignment courtroom, all people with non-violent chargesopen or closed- needing services are welcome to participate.

Interface Peer Navigators will be embedded in Department 11 to directly connect justice-involved people with services through Interface, Turning Point and various government agencies. Services provided will include, inter alia, housing, mental health/substance abuse treatment, and assistance obtaining identification and government benefits, as well as transportation to these resources.


The program is set to begin on March 3, 2025, and is open to all people with non-violent criminal offenses, open or closed, in the Ventura County Superior Court.

Notable Arbitration Award in Lange v. Mulder, et al.

Attorneys Jill L. Friedman and Michael J. Pellegrini of Myers, Widders, Gibson, Jones & Feingold, LLP representing Plaintiff Cari Lange, obtained a significant award in the case of Cari Lange v. Kerry Mulder, et al. Plaintiff Cari Lange was awarded \$3,191,061.38 in damages against defendants Kerry and Robert Mulder. This real estate fraud and breach of contract dispute arose after Lange purchased a hillside property in February 2020, which the Mulders had flipped after making unpermitted and superficial modifications to disguise its severe structural issues. The case was arbitrated by Hon. Vincent J. O'Neill who found in favor of Lange.

THE FACTUAL CLAIMS

The Mulders, who were prolific property flippers, purchased the highly distressed view property in 2019 for \$785,000. Prior to purchase, they hired a general contractor to inspect the property. The contractor outlined several structural and safety issues, including problems with the structural foundation beams. The Mulders used this information to negotiate a credit on the purchase. They put the property on the market with little modification. When several potential buyers withdrew their offers and the property fell out of escrow, the Mulders took the property off the market and made substantial and unpermitted modifications before putting it back on the market for \$1,300,000. Plaintiff purchased the property in February 2020.


Plaintiff's Contentions: The hillside property was in grave disrepair, a condition that the Mulders became increasingly aware of as they attempted to sell and alter it. With no construction expertise and the help of unlicensed laborers, they made low quality, superficial changes to disguise its fundamental failings. Through misrepresentations, failures to disclose, and concealment, and with the help of an inexperienced real estate broker who represented both sides, Defendants sold the property to Plaintiff with a short escrow and inspection contingency period. Plaintiff's inspectors did not do destructive testing, nor did they have reason to suspect that such testing was needed.

Defendant's Contentions: The Mulders claimed that the property was sold "as is" and that they "over disclosed," pointing to all the reports that were turned over as part of the mandated disclosure packet.


